UNSAFE MEDICATION

Contra Costa Environmental Health has found markets selling prescription medications without a pharmacy license. Do not use these medicines – they could be dangerous.

- Only a doctor can safely prescribe medicine
- Only a licensed pharmacy can guarantee the medicine is safe and real
- Medications from unlicensed markets can be expired, counterfeit or mislabeled
- Taking the wrong medication can make you very sick

Talk to your doctor if you need medication or call 1-800-771-4270 if you do not have health insurance. Only use prescription medication from a licensed pharmacy.
