**REGULATED SUBSTANCES REGISTRATION
PROCESS/CHEMICAL INFORMATION FORM
INSTRUCTIONS**

Following are the instructions to fill out the Process/Chemical Information form. This form is to be filled out for each process. Information for three processes can be filled out per sheet.

1. Name of Process: The name the stationary source has given to the process to differentiate it from other processes
2. Process NAICS: The North American Industrial Classification System for the process
3. Program Level: CalARP Program level 1, 2 or 3
4. Regulated Substance: Chemical(s) handled above the threshold quantity in a process that is regulated under the California Accidental Release Prevention Program (see enclosed table). List each regulated substance separately.
5. CAS #: The chemical abstract number for each regulated substance
6. Maximum Quantity In Pounds: The maximum quantity of the regulated substance in the process
7. Flammable Mixture (Common Name): The name given to the flammable mixtures in the process (all the flammable mixtures in the process are treated as one regulated mixture).
8. NFPA: The National Fire Protection Association fire rating for the flammable mixture
9. Maximum Quantity in Pounds: The maximum quantity of the flammable mixture in the process
10. Maximum Storage Temperature: The maximum storage temperature of regulated substance/flammable mixture in the process
11. Maximum Storage Pressure: The maximum storage pressure of regulated substance/flammable mixture in the process
12. Maximum Process Temperature: The maximum process temperature of regulated substance/flammable mixture in the process
13. Maximum Process Pressure: The maximum process pressure of regulated substance/flammable mixture in the process
