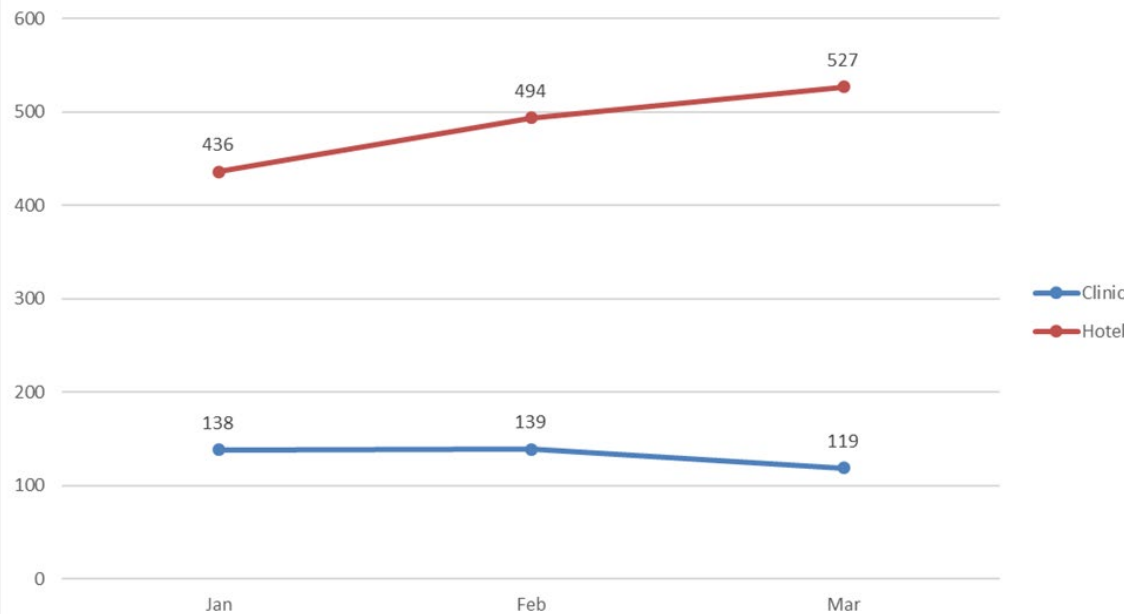

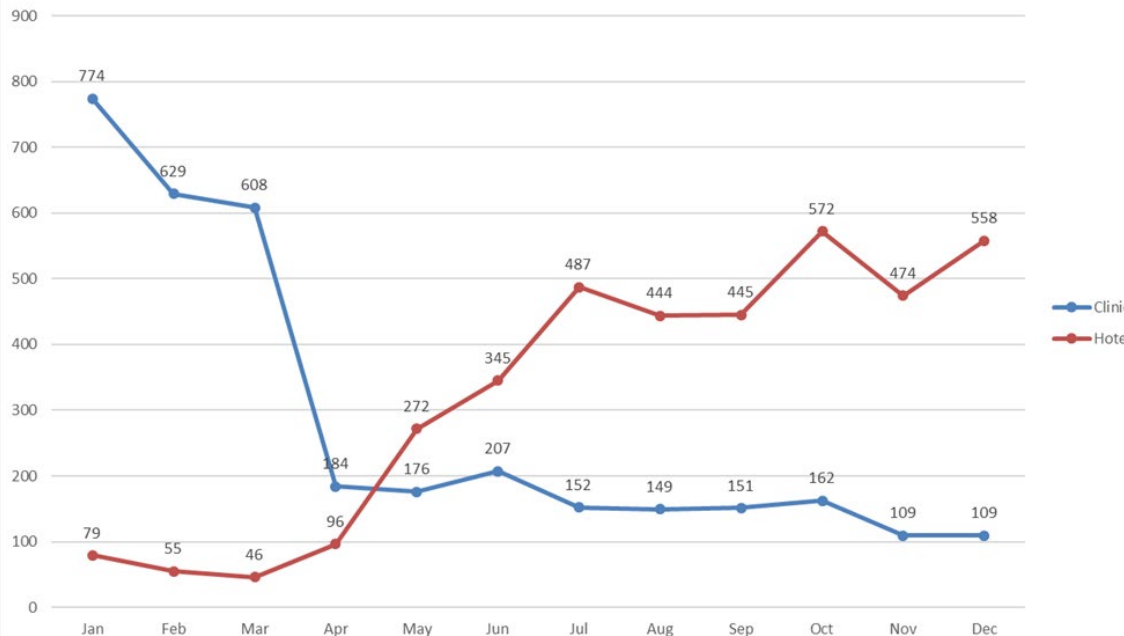

2021 HCH Visits by Type



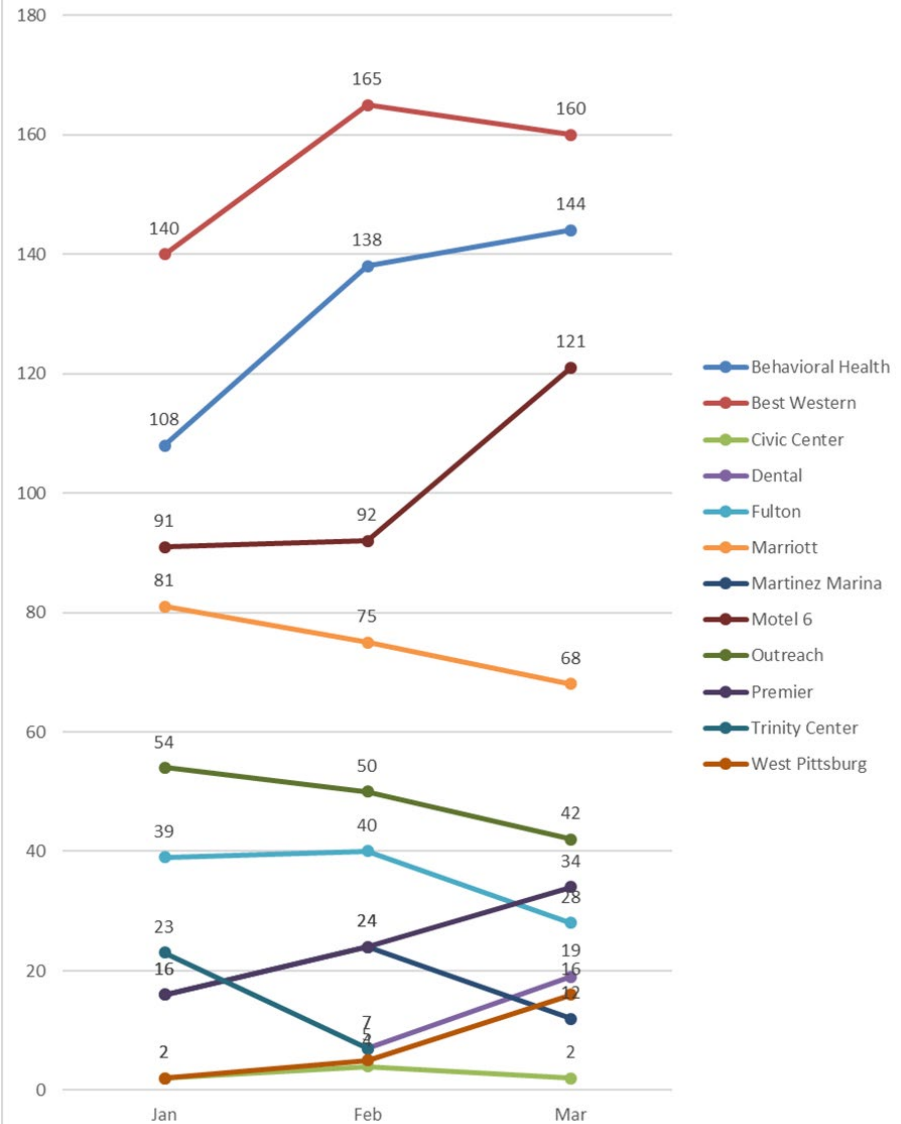
- There were 1,853 HCH visits in the first three months of 2021, serving a total of 581 unique patients.
- 78.6% of HCH visits took place at one of the hotel clinics and 61.1% of total patients served were seen at a hotel site.

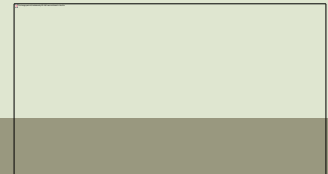
