Also, I noticed that several public comments were omitted from the meeting minutes even when they were referenced (item 3.) as having been attached in the minutes. 1. Minutes correction on page 3, item 7, 3rd bullet item:

Please change "Susan JunFish of PfSE asked.... "

to "Susan JunFish of PASE asked if Pestec had a chance to find out how Santa Clara County was able to eliminate all glueboards at all *their* detention facilities to control rodents in a more humane way."

2. Please correct quote on page 5, item #9 that begins with "Susan JunFish of PfSE said..." to: Susan JunFish of PASE read the 1st paragraph of the County's IPM Policy and noted that the county policy addresses county pest programs, not programs outside of county staff treatments. She asked that the county prioritize and address county's programs where continued pesticide usage has been of concern by the community, namely rodenticides in open space and herbicides in the Right of Way *prior* to addressing Bed Bugs.

She also asked that the newly formed Committee members may wish to voice their priorities for subcommittee topics for 2016 instead of having to work on subcommittees chosen by those who have left in 2015. Michael Sullivan seconded Susan's statements.

3. Please correct quote on item #10:

"Susan JunFish of PfSE disagreed..." to

Susan JunFish of PASE stated that the county's study noted the rate of water flow and the times when the application started and when sampling took place downstream. According to her calculations, sampling took place after any herbicide that may have drifted into the water, would have been missed. Cece said she did not have time to look at Susan's inquiry sent by e-mail last year. Susan said that the county may be presenting inaccurate conclusion about herbicides not being detected in the FCD treatment due to insupportable scientific design and second, due to grab sampling being ineffective for detecting herbicide contamination in a moving stream.
